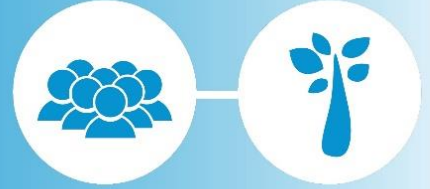

Purpose

You will be required to undertake a range of plant operation and labouring duties to assist a variety of areas within Council such as: parks, roads, water and sewerage, aerodromes, cemeteries, waste, animal management, facilities and local development within the Yuleba, Wallumbilla, Jackson and surrounding areas.

The role works under the direction and supervision of the Team Leader – Town & Surrounds (Wallumbilla / Yuleba / Jackson).

Key responsibilities

• Town and asset maintenance

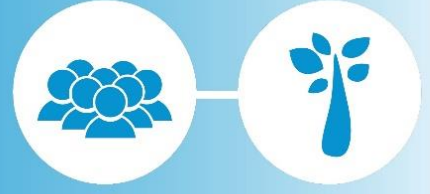
- Ensure town entrances are presentable by slashing, spraying and mowing
- Litter collection in streets, parks, open spaces and town approaches
- Maintain and clean culverts, gutters, drains and streets
- Perform general maintenance to parks, gardens and open spaces by mowing, weed control/spraying, irrigation, landscaping and pruning
- Perform minor pavement and footpath repairs/maintenance as required

• Plant operations

- Safety operate Council's plant as per the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) specifications and Council's policies and procedures
- Undertake regular servicing and maintenance for plant, equipment and machinery to ensure optimal capacity and efficiency levels and avoid unnecessary operational downtime
- Report any faults through Council's fault reporting system
- Maintain plant records as per Council's IMMS and plant management policies and procedures

- **Labour support**

- Undertake general labour duties and participate in multi-skilled team tasks as required
- Perform work site preparation and clean up
- Setting up traffic control signage as per Council's traffic control plans

- **Interdepartmental support**

- Provide support and assistance to the Local Development team with the delivery of community-based projects and partnership programs
- Perform duties required to ensure Council meet current Service Level Agreement (SLA) between Maintenance Delivery & Works and Development, Facilities & Environmental Services Departments in the areas of Waste and Facilities
- Complete tasks required to ensure Councils (SLA) is met between Maintenance Delivery & Works and Corporate & Community Services Departments in the areas of Community Safety and Cemeteries
- Provide support to assist Council meet (SLA) between Maintenance Delivery & Works and Airport Departments

- **Other**

- Complete all required Integrated Maranoa Management System (IMMS) forms and checklists in a timely manner
- Undertake duties within the skill level, competence and training, consistent with the applicable level within the Award, in any area of Council as required
- Assume the accountabilities as per the established role dimensions for the position
- Demonstrate a strong commitment to Maranoa Regional Council's values and team goals

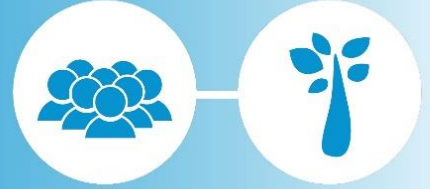

Qualifications and licences

- **Mandatory qualifications and licences**

To be successful you will need to demonstrate that you will be able to meet the below mandatory requirements for the role:

- Current LR (Light Rigid) Class Driver Licence
- General Construction Induction (White) Card
- Verification of Skills Level to Competently Operate Mobile Plant (in particular Backhoe, Slasher, Mower)

- **Desirable qualifications and licences**

Although not mandatory, the below qualifications and licences are considered beneficial to the role:

- Chainsaw certificate of competency
- ACDC Chemical Accreditation (Certificate and Licence)
- RIIWHS302D – Implement Traffic Management Plan
- Certificate II in Horticulture (or equivalent)
- Certificate II in Civil Construction – Road Construction and Maintenance (or equivalent)

Required skills and experience

To be successful in this role you will have:

- Ability to perform manual handling and labouring duties for extended periods in direct sunlight, working in difficult terrain, walking on uneven ground, prolonged sitting whilst operating plant / machinery hand and foot controls
- Ability to follow direction and complete tasks within allocated timeframes to required standard
- Demonstrated ability to work productively both within a team environment and unsupervised
- Ability to safely operate mobile plant and equipment within a construction/maintenance environment
- Commitment and ability to demonstrate a strong commitment to Maranoa Regional Council's values and team goals
- Previous experience working in local government, construction/maintenance or similar environment will be highly regarded but is not essential
