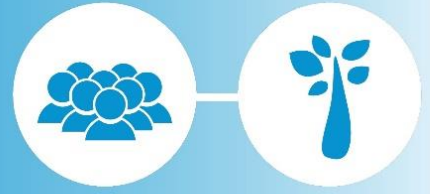

- Current C (Car) Class Driver Licence
- Queensland Health – Health (Drugs and Poisons) approval for "Fluoroacetic Acid and Strychnine for vertebrate pest control" – (1080 distribution licence)
- Weapons licence (Category A and B)
- Humane destruction (or ability to acquire within 3 months)
- Q – Fever test / vaccination (or ability to acquire if required)
- Tetanus Vaccination (or ability to acquire within 3 months)
- Hepatitis B Vaccination (or ability to acquire within 3 months)
- Previous experience in the capture and humane destruction of pest animals
