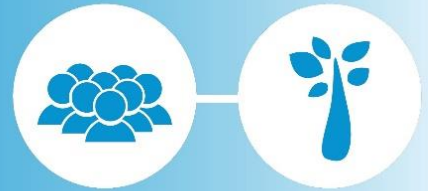

Key responsibilities

• Plant operation

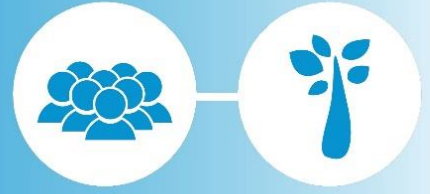
- Safely operate and maintain Council's plant and equipment as per the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) specifications and Council's policies and procedures
- Undertake daily servicing and maintenance for plant, equipment and machinery to ensure optimal capacity and efficiency levels and to avoid unscheduled operational downtime
- Maintain plant records as per Council's Integrated Maranoa Management System (IMMS) and plant management policies and procedures
- Provide skilled plant operation to assist with capital works as well as maintenance repairs/renewals/upgrades
- Operate a variety of handheld tools and machinery as required

• Labour support

- Undertake general labouring duties and participate in multi-skilled team tasks as directed
- Perform manual duties to contribute to water, sewerage and gas repairs, upgrades and renewals
- Carry out site preparation and clean up for specific

- **Water, sewerage & gas maintenance**

- Maintenance of work sites and general housekeeping prior to completion including mowing, slashing, weed control and collection of waste material
- Repairs to fences, gates, buildings and other structures
- Complete traffic control signage set up, maintenance and collect as per traffic control plans
- Maintenance of valve and hydrant boxes and markers
- Contribute to preventative maintenance tasks as required
- Assist with water main repairs and sewer blockages and overflows
- Maintenance of services at other council facilities

- **Water, sewerage & gas operations**

- Perform site visits and take samples and readings as required
- Collection and swapping of chemical containers
- Conduct gas meter readings as required

- **Other**

- Undertake duties within the skill level, competence and training, consistent with the applicable level within the Award, in any area of Council as required
- Assume the accountabilities and responsibilities as per the relevant role dimensions and delegations for the position

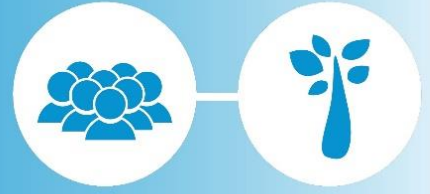

Qualifications and licences

- **Mandatory qualifications and licences**

To be successful you will need to demonstrate that you will be able to meet the below mandatory requirements for the role:

- Current C (Car) Class Driver Licence
- Verification of Skills Level to Competently Operate Mobile Plant (in particular excavator, backhoe, bobcat)
- General Construction Induction (White) Card
- Authorised Person & Local Government Worker Training (in-house training provided)

- **Desirable qualifications and licences**

Although not mandatory, the below qualifications and licences are considered beneficial to the role:

- Current MR Class Driver Licence (*or ability to obtain within six (6) months of commencement*)
- Operate and Maintain Chainsaws
- ACDC Chemical Accreditation (Certificate and Licence)
- RIIWHS302D – Implement Traffic Management Plan
- Certificate II in Plumbing/Drainlaying (or equivalent)

Required skills and experience

To be successful in this role you will have:

- Ability to perform manual handling and labouring duties for extended periods in direct sunlight, working in difficult terrain, walking on uneven ground, prolonged sitting whilst operating plant / machinery hand and foot controls
- Ability to follow direction and complete tasks within allocated timeframes to required standard
- Demonstrated ability to work productively both within a team environment and unsupervised
- Ability to safely operate mobile plant and equipment within a construction environment
- Ability to demonstrate a strong commitment to Maranoa Regional Council's values and team goals
- Previous experience working in local government, construction or similar environment will be highly regarded but is not essential
