

Yuleba Booster Facility Public Artwork Expression of Interest

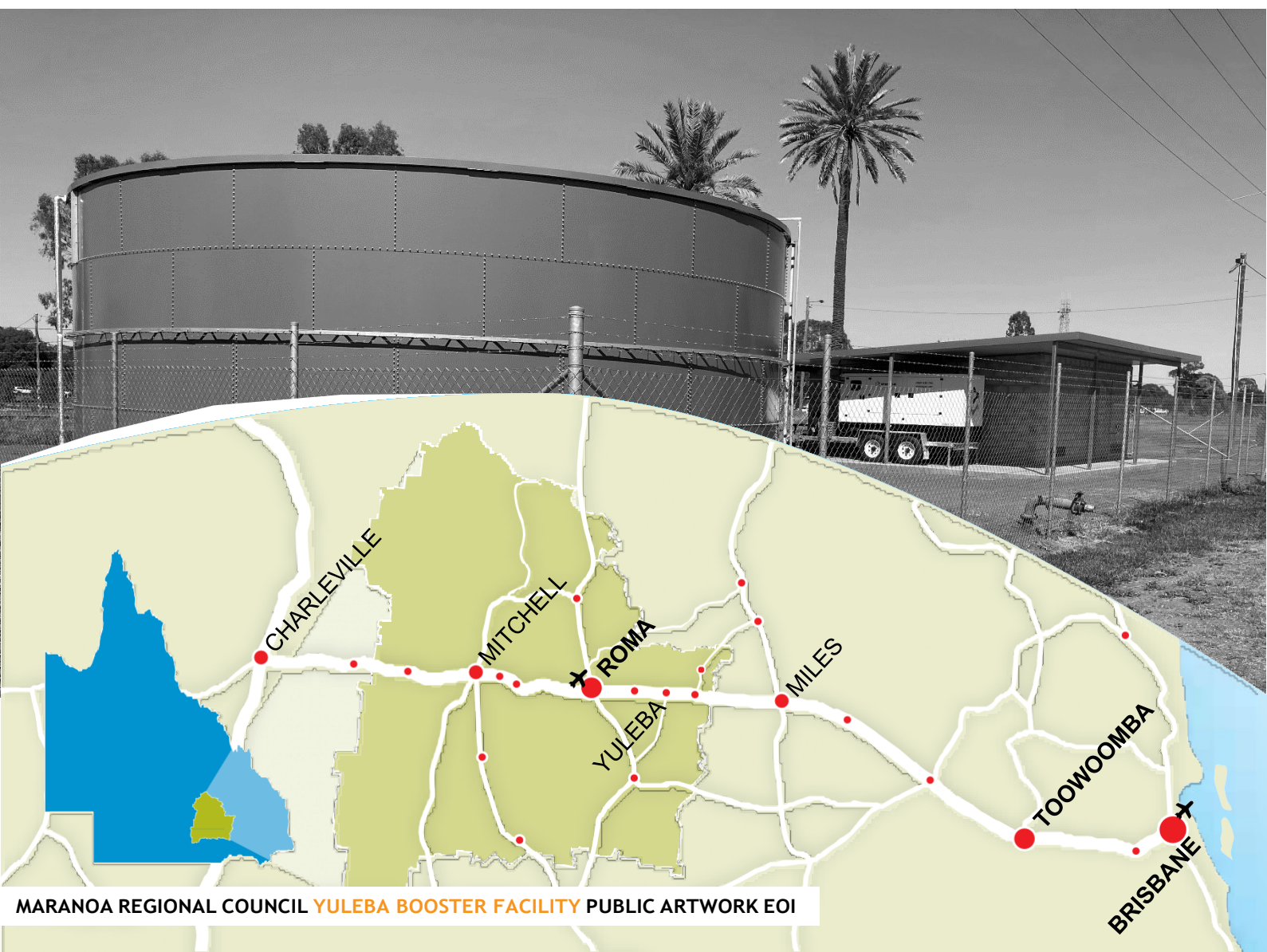


Introduction

Maranoa Regional Council is inviting submissions from suitably qualified artists to create artwork outdoors on a fence to be constructed around the water booster facility at Garden Street Yuleba.

The mural site is situated on the main entry road into the town of Yuleba and may be visual from the Warrego Highway. The successful artist will workshop with the local community to develop a design which is to be approved by Council.

Artists working in all mediums are encouraged to apply. There is a commitment to including quality public artworks in the development that enhances a user's experience of place and space, to educate, delight and strengthen the local community. To contribute to the region's unique history and character for the local residents and the travelling public.



Submission Requirements

Artists who are interested in being considered must address the following requirements and process:

Completed Expression of Interest Form

Cover page with artist name and details

Curriculum Vitae outlining relevant artistic experience

Short artist statement/biography, including artist's relationship to the Maranoa region/themes (max 300 words)

Previous works, including public artworks or demonstrating relevance to public art, accompanied with image details

PLEASE NOTE:

- Concepts are not required at this stage and will not be accepted.
- We recommend using standard fonts as special graphics may not appear the same on all computers

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

EOI submitted in correct format with all requirements <i>(if this is not met, the application will be ineligible)</i>	50%
Artistic merit	25%
Suitability for public art opportunities	25%

Selection is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Submission must be received Tuesday, 30 November 2021 by 5pm

Limit of two submissions per artist.

SELECTION

- Artists will be shortlisted according as per the Evaluation Criteria.
- Final artist selection will rest with Maranoa Regional Council.

DESIGN DEVELOPMENT

- The selected artist will work with the local community during a Community Consultation to develop the design
- Maranoa Regional Council will review and approve design.

FABRICATION AND INSTALLATION

- Artworks proceed to fabrication and installation stage.
