<ul> <li>A site plan showing adjoining Real Property lot Descriptions, Street Names, Street Numbers &amp; Site Boundaries</li> <li>Distance between the pool fencing and lot boundaries and the doors and windows of the dwelling.</li> <li>Show the extent of earthworks (if any) on the site plan.</li> <li>The site plan is to be drawn to a suitable scale of not less than 1:200 and is to be dimensioned.</li> </ul>		
Provide details and plans of the pool. If the pool is to be constructed on the site, provide engineering certification of the construction. Include the construction type of the pool and water capacity.		
The type and location of fencing and gates to be installed around the pool		
Indicate on the plan where the pool equipment is to be located		
Indicate type and position of construction fencing		
Details of the type of pool filter and circulation pump to be installed.		
Provide details of the electrical earthing provisions for the pool equipment.		
Show the location of all services on the site i.e. water, sewerage, connections		
The proposed method of disposing of pool water on the site

Applications not conforming to the abovementioned requirements will not be classed as a properly made application in accordance with the *Planning Act 2016*. As a result, the timeframe for the assessment for the application will not commence until all information has been submitted to Council.

Council may require further information in addition to that set out above. Where further information is required, you will be notified within the time frames set down in the *Planning Act 2016*.

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
