IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Your artwork will be installed in a public space and as such, your supporting documentation should be comprehensive and include the required information outlined below in order for it to be assessed as suitable for such a space. Should your submission not include this important documentation it may be deemed non-conforming and not eligible for consideration.

Your submission can include a completed work or a work in progress.

Your submission MUST include clear and comprehensive support documentation including:

- Support images of completed or partly completed work Maximum size 2 -3 MB and 300dpi
- Information and drawings of foundation and footings
- Detail on any lighting included with the sculpture
- Machinery required
- Plinth details (if required)
- Maintenance required.
- Concept drawings that are to scale with front and side elevations.
