## Annual Kerbside Collection

### 2025 DATES AND DETAILS



It's time to tidy the house and garden to take advantage of Council's FREE kerbside rubbish collection. Rid your living space of any broken/unused domestic goods, green waste and scrap metal.

Residents are reminded to hold off on placing items on the kerb until Friday, 21 March 2025.

## How to ensure your waste is collected:

1. Your unwanted items must be separated into three piles - bulky household items, green waste and metal waste. **Mixed piles will not be collected.**
2. Ensure the items are placed out on the footpath by 7:00pm the day before collection starts in your area.
3. Items cannot be collected from under trees, near power poles or stormwater drains or from within private yards.
4. Items must be easily and safely lifted by two people.
5. Place glass items to one side for safe collection.
6. Council will not collect piles greater than 3m<sup>3</sup> in total. Piles should be no bigger than 1m high x 1m wide x 3m long.
7. This service will be available to properties in town areas. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer this service to rural residents.

### Remember:

Ensure the items are placed out on the footpath **by 7pm the day before** collection starts in your area.

Please also remember to **separate your unwanted items into 3 separate piles**. Also keep piles smaller than 3m<sup>3</sup> (anything larger will not be collected).

### Unacceptable Items

### Acceptable Items

- ✓ Furniture and white goods
- ✓ Scrap metal
- ✓ Wood products
- ✓ Household appliances
- ✓ Green waste (no more than 1.5m in length and 3m<sup>3</sup> in total)
