Focaccia

Ingredients Dough:

12/3 cups bread flour

4tsp white Sugar 11/4tsp salt

1 tsp instant yeast

3/4 cup very warm water

11/2 tbsp extra virgin olive


1/2 cup boiled and mashed

potato (packed)

For baking:

4 tbsp extra virgin olive oil 1/2 tsp sea salt flakes





Dry ingredients: Place flour, salt, sugar and yeast in a large bowl and mix well.

3.Wet ingredients: Make a well in the centre, then add olive oil and warm water. Mix until you can no longer see flour. Dough should be sticky - too sticky to knead by hand.

4.Add potato: Add mashed potato. Using a folding motion, start mixing it through. Then start smearing it along the walls of the bond. Once potato is evenly incorporated, shape roughly into a ball in the bond.

5.Rise I: Cover bowl with cling wrap, then place in a warm place for 30 minutes. Dough should roughly double in size.

6. Rise 2: Drizzle 2 teaspoons of olive oil around the edges of the dough. Fold the edges of the dough into the centre six times. Shape into bowl and cover with cling wrap. Put bowl in a warm place for 30 minutes. Dough should roughly double in size.

 $7. \textbf{Prepare pan:} \ Meanwhile, prepare the pan by pouring in 2 tablespoons of olive oil, then smear it all across the base and along the walls.$

8.Preheat oven: Preheat oven to 220C. Allow time to ensure oven has been preheated for at least 15 minutes.

9.Rise 3: Scrape dough into prepared pan. Stretch and pull to fill the base as best you can and get the surface roughly level. Cover pan with cling wrap, then put in a warm place for 40 minutes until dough expands and fills the

10.Prepare for baking: Drizzle the surface with two teaspoons of olive oil, and smear/rub it over lightly with your hands.

11.Poke: Using both hands like claws, push fingers deep into the dough, right to the base of the pan to create dimples. Do this around half a dozen rimes across dough surface.

12.Toppings: Add toppings of choice, Drizzle the surface with 2 tablespoons of olive oil so it runs into the dimples. Then sprinkle with sea salt flakes.

13.Bake: Bake for 25-30 minutes until the top is deep golden and lightly crisp, while the sides are fried and crusty

14.Cool; Turn out onto a cooling rack. Let it rest for at least 10 minutes before cutting to serve.


