We are excited to announce that our Community Collection Manager (CCM) is now live on Aurora, your local library network, replacing the old 'Suggestion for Purchase' form.

Recommend and reserve a title with a single click and keep track of your recommendations with My Activity tracker.

Offering a user-friendly bookshop look and feel, CCM allows you to easily browse and search for new and upcoming titles, make recommendations for purchase, and place reservations - all in one streamlined process.

When you place a reserve, it automatically recommends the title for purchase and adds your reservation to Aurora.

Additionally, you can recommend titles that are not currently listed, navigate through various formats and genres, and view your current recommendations and reservations with ease.

To access, go to Aurora your local library network, click on suggestions in the top menu bar to link to CCM. Now login with your library card number and pin.

Suggest a new title today and help us shape our collections to better serve your needs and interests.

- Link family members to your account


